ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

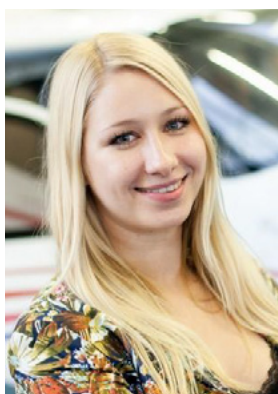
