Assessment methods include essays, reports, presentations and case studies, as well as time-constrained in-class tests and exams. Classes are held on weekdays in small cohorts to ensure you receive full support and get the best out of the programme and increase the effectiveness of the educational process. Our lecturers include international experts and practitioners, whose daily work is related to international finance and accounting.
