
The Integro multi-search engine (library catalogue)

The electronic catalogue (Integro multi-search engine) informs about the collection of our Library.



It is possible to change the language in the menu. You can choose between polish, english or ukrainian language.




How to login in to library account



- 1) Using your Student's card number (e.g. w12345) and password PESEL (Personal ID number is on your Student's card) or
- 2) log in with Azure Ad using your university mail address and enter your password (in the same way as you log on to the Virtual university).

Search by all fields

The Integro catalogue provides the possibility to search by the entire bibliographic description. By selecting "All fields" we can search any set of words from the entire description (title, author, series, year of publication, etc.).



Search by author and title


We use the "Author" and/or "Title" fields when searching for a specific author and/or title.

Search by subject

Use the "Subject" field to search for publications in a particular field without knowing the author and/or title. Enter the keyword you are interested in and the system will display the keywords found and, together with the suggested terms, narrow down the search term.

Searching by different criteria

Integro makes it possible to find publications using the sorting function of the search results using different criteria. The selection can be made using the SEARCH RESULTS extracted in the left panel of the Integro interface divided into sections.



Data source - results in library catalog or in digital resources,

Library - list of the two libraries forming the consortium,

Department - the library that has the book in question in its collection,

Item type - books, periodicals and journals, computer file, papers or articles ect.,

Author,

Subject,

Publication year and Period of creation,

Domain,

Genre - books, ebook, article, journals etc,

Target groups,

Characteristics of author,






The results can be sorted by: relevance of author, title and year of publication, rating each time sorting in ascending or descending order.

How to order books







The possibility of ordering is indicated by the status "Available". Below is the "Request" button.



After clicking on the "Request" button, the system redirects the reader to the request cart.



Here you can send your order by clicking on "Confirm request" or "Cancel request".




Once the order has been sent, the system will display a message about the expected time for processing the order and delivering the document to the selected point.

How to renew books online

To renew your books online you must log in to your account. Your online library account lists the items you have borrowed with their due dates.

User account



To renew an item:

- all items borrowed by the reader must not be overdue in a certain lending department;
- the sum of all fines and fees must be equal to 0 (zero) in a certain lending department.
- if any of above conditions are not fulfilled, the item cannot be renewed and instead of a "Renew" link, "Info" link will be available. After clicking the link, the reader will get a page with an explanation why the item cannot be renewed.

To renew an item (books) please click "Prolong" or "Prolong all" link



Booking

When the book you are looking for has the status "Unavailable", you can reserve it.



After selecting the "Book" button, the possibility of reserving any copy or copies from the selected agency (Rzeszów or Kielnarowa) appears. In the next step, the reader sets a waiting period for the book and, once approved, has the document reserved.


Once the book is returned by the reader currently in possession of it, the reserved document will be transferred to the account in the "Requested items →Unsent" tab.

You will then **need to send a request** for this book according to the ordering procedure described earlier.

How to order a copy

After logging in to the INTEGRO catalog it is possible to order document scans.


You can order 4 scans of 30 pages each.



Click on the "Order copy" button. The key may be gray:

- if the books are overdue,
- you have unpaid penalties,
- you have exceeded the maximum number of orders.

Create a copy order




It is obligatory to specify the **page range** field, optionally the reader can also write his comments to the order (we give the range of pages, e.g. 45-56). All agreements should also be checked.

After completing all mandatory fields click "Order" button. After sending the order, the reader is automatically moved to the tab Reprographic orders / Scans, where he can see details of his order.

Downloading scans

The completed and sent order is received by the reader after logging in to his account in INTEGRO or in the mobile application. The reader is informed that the materials are already available for collection: by e-mail and by notification in INTEGRO catalog.


Scans are ready to be collected on your user account in the tab Reprographic orders -> Scans. After selecting the option Actions -> Download




E-book lending library

In the INTEGRO catalog, readers can search for e-books (limited by the e-book format facet see the menu on the left →ltem format →ebook format), check their availability and borrow to their account or reserve unavailable copies.


After selecting the option "Items" - the reader has the possibility to borrow online. If a copy is currently unavailable, the reader can reserve it. Access to lending and reserving options is dependent on the reader's agendas and limits. Borrowing a copy is done by selecting the button "Borrow online".



After accepting the checkbox with the Terms of use and approving the loan - the document is loaned to the reader's account.



The user is automatically transferred to the "Borrowed items". Under the "Actions" button, the reader can use the available e-books. MOBI and EPUB files are downloaded directly to the reader's device (smartphone, computer). PDF files are opened in a special viewer.



When the reader selects **Browse PDF**, a new tab opens with a viewer that displays the PDF file. The tool does not allow for: print, saving the file, copying the text.

Returns of eBooks

Returns of ebooks take place without a librarian. The reader can perform the return in the ACCOUNT \rightarrow Borrowed documents section \rightarrow Actions \rightarrow Return.



After logging in to the application using the data from the reader's account, the user of the application can:

Health Source - Consumer Edition

Consumer Edition provides access to nearly 80 full text, consumer health magazines.

Health Source: Nursing/Academic Edition

This database provides nearly 550 scholarly full text journals focusing on many medical disciplines. Health Source: Nursing/Academic Edition also features the AHFS Consumer Medication Information, which covers 1,300 generic drug patient education sheets with more than 4,700 brand names.

Library, Information Science & Technology Abstracts

LISTA indexes more than 560 core journals, nearly 50 priority journals, and nearly 125 selective journals; plus books, research reports and proceedings. Subject coverage includes librarianship, classification, cataloging, bibliometrics, online information retrieval, information management and more. Coverage in the database extends back as far as the mid-1960s.

AHFS Consumer Medication Information

AHFS Consumer Medication Information is a trusted source and recognized standard for patient drug information, available in both English and Spanish. Published by the American Society of Health-System Pharmacists, AHFS includes more than a thousand drug information monographs written in lay language for consumers and has been a Top Ten Award Winner in the Department of Health and Human Services National Consumer Education Materials Contest. This content is updated monthly.

Agricola

This database contains bibliographic records from the U.S. Department of Agriculture's National Agricultural Library. Coverage for AGRICOLA dates back to 1970 and includes more than 4.8 million citations. The citations are comprised of journal articles, monographs, theses, patents, software, audiovisual materials, and technical reports related to agriculture.

MasterFILE Premier

Designed specifically for public libraries, this multidisciplinary database provides full text for nearly 1,700 periodicals with full-text information dating as far back as 1975. Covering virtually every subject area of general interest, MasterFILE Premier also contains full text for nearly 500 reference books and over 164,400 primary source documents, as well as an Image Collection of over 592,000 photos, maps & flags. This database is updated daily via EBSCOhost.

MEDLINE

MEDLINE provides authoritative medical information on medicine, nursing, dentistry, veterinary medicine, the health care system, pre-clinical sciences, and much more. Created by the National Library of Medicine, MEDLINE uses MeSH (Medical Subject Headings) indexing with tree, tree hierarchy, subheadings and explosion capabilities to search citations from over 5,400 current biomedical journals.

Newspaper Source

Newspaper Source provides cover-to-cover full text for more than 40 (U.S.) & international newspapers. The database also contains selective full text for 389 regional (U.S.) newspapers.

In addition, full text television & radio news transcripts are also provided.
